## **MnDOT** Airport Classifications

30

Key - have a paved and lighted primary runway 5,000 feet or greater in length

- have a paved and lighted primary runway that is less
- than 5,000 feet in length
- + 22 Landing Strip -

have one or more turf runways which can accommodate most single-engine aircraft and some twin-engine aircraft

The State Aviation System Plan (SASP) is updated every 5-7 years, last updated in 2012

The FAA funds a majority of the SASP
