Asset management is a systematic and strategic approach to better decision making. The Asset Management Project Office is working to provide leadership, guidance, and expertise in asset management principles and practices.

Asset Management Project Office is in the process of implementing a Statewide Enterprise Asset Management software called **Transportation Asset Management System (TAMS)**. TAMS will provide a home for over 14+ asset classes, have over 1900 users to train and support, and will provide data for \$30M in annual maintenance budget decisions. Implementation of TAMS includes major workflow and business process improvements for specialty areas like Hydraulics and Traffic. Traffic Signals, Lighting, and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) have already been implemented and have ~100 users.

Georilla is an internal web-map application that is currently being used by ~700 unique visitors per month to mash-up asset, project, and activity information to make better data-driven decisions. The Asset Management Project Office Supports the development and direction of Georilla.

Asset Management State of Practice - Along with the FHWA and a consultant, the Asset Management Project Office is currently conducting a state of practice assessment of asset management procedures for 11 different asset classes. This assessment will identify gaps in our practices and provide the agency with solutions and suggestions on how to improve our asset management program.

A \$3.4M **Statewide Mobile LiDAR Barrier Assessment Project** is currently in progress to capture inventory information for 13 asset classes and assess barrier deficiencies. The Asset Management Project Office is a project management partner, assuring data integrity and engaging asset stakeholders.
