

Attachment to: Fall Harvest Permit

This Permit allows transport of sugar beets, potatoes, or carrots from the field of harvest to the point of first unloading; per MN Statute 169.826 s1 (a).

The permit is valid from the beginning of harvest to November 30th of the year issued.

Maximum weight allowed under this permit is 10 percent (10%) above the vehicle's normal axle or axle group weight.

This MnDOT permit authorizes movement only over United States (US) and Minnesota State (MN) Routes.
Movement on Interstate Highways is not allowed.

This Permit does not authorize movement on county, city, or township roads.

This permit does not supersede any posted bridge or road restrictions.

Permit is issued to one power unit. The serial number (VIN) must be listed on the permit along with the vehicle make and license plate number.

Vehicle(s) must be legal dimensions. This permit only authorizes 10% over normal legal operating weights.

Front steer axle tires may not exceed 600 lbs. per inch width of tire; non-steer axle tires may not exceed 500 lbs. per inch width of tire, or manufacturer's tire rating – whichever is less.

This permit must be carried in the hauling vehicle during move.

Permit may not be transferred to another power unit.

Permit fee is \$60.00.

This Permit has no bearing on vehicle registration requirements. Vehicle must be properly registered for the gross weight being hauled.
