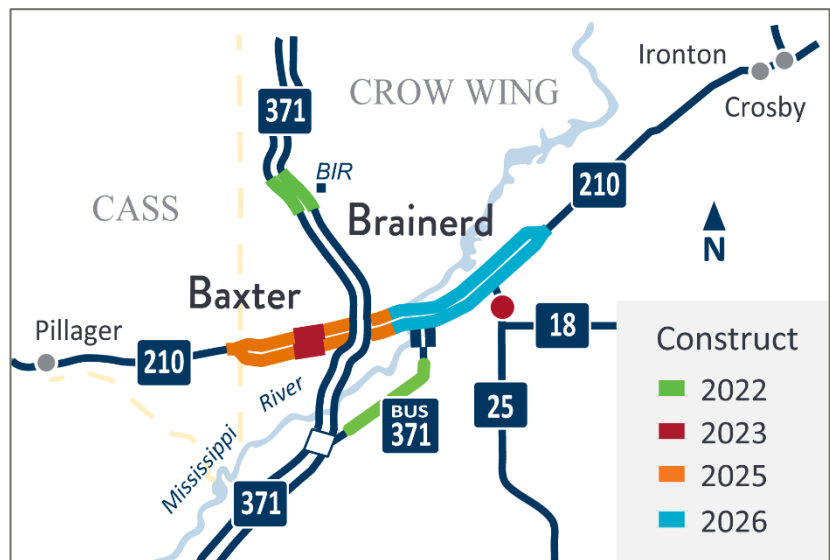


Future projects in Brainerd/Baxter area

Planned state highway and bridge projects through 2027:

- In 2022, improve Business Hwy 371 between Barrows and Brainerd.
 - Reconstruct Hwy 371B from Greenwood St. (Crow Wing Co. Rd. 23) to Joseph St. in Brainerd, includes sidewalks and signal upgrades at Industrial Park Rd./Buffalo Hills Ln.
 - Resurface Hwy 371B from 70th Ave. in Barrows to Greenwood St. in Brainerd, includes left turn lanes at Greenwood St., St. Mathias Rd. and 70th Ave.
- In 2022–2023, install Reduced Conflict Intersections (RCIs) on Hwy 371 to improve access and motorist safety at Co. Rd. 125/Gull Lake Dam Rd. and Co. Rd. 126/Green Gables Rd. in Brainerd, includes new frontage road access.
- In 2023, City of Baxter to improve and reconstruct Hwy 210 access to Inglewood Dr. (add signal) and Knollwood Dr. (remove signal), includes Foley Rd. frontage road access.
- In 2023, replace the Hwy 25 bridge over the BNSF Railway line, north of Hwy 18/Oak St. in Brainerd, includes multi-use trail to 28th Ave. E. Project includes a detour.
- In 2025, resurface and improve access on both directions of Hwy 210 between Baxter Dr. and Timberwood Dr. A corridor study has been completed.
- In 2026–2027, reconstruct and improve both directions of Hwy 210/Washington St. from Baxter Dr. to the east end of the four-lane in Brainerd, includes pedestrian sidewalks and intersection improvements. A corridor study has been completed.
