

ATP-7 Operating Procedures/Policies

According to the *ATP-7 Operating Procedures/Policies*, the ATP is tasked with annually reviewing its operating procedures in the summer months. As part of this regular review, staff has proposed some changes.

Proposed changes

The following adjustments are proposed. Additional changes may be suggested by members of the ATP. With ATP concurrence, the *ATP-7 Operating Procedures/Policies* will be updated.

Page	Current language	Proposed change
7	<i>Meetings:</i> “ATP-7 will hold a minimum of five meetings per year.”	ATP-7 will meet as needed to complete the business of the ATP.
7	<i>Meetings:</i> “ATP meetings will vary throughout the District to accommodate local tours/outreach requests.”	ATP meetings may vary throughout the District to accommodate local tours and outreach requests.
9	<i>Regional Development Commission Representatives (RDC):</i> “RDC’s make the appointment at their annual meeting, which is held in July.”	Remove sentence.
9	<i>Elected Officials:</i> “Elected official representatives continue to serve unless they choose to remove themselves, or they are not successful in their attempt at re-election.”	Elected official representatives may continue to serve unless they choose to remove themselves or they no longer hold an elected seat in the same governmental body.
9	<i>Transit Representatives:</i> “One will be from a rural transit provider and one from the MPO.”	One provider will be from a rural transit agency and the other from an urbanized transit agency, as defined by Federal Transit Administration formula apportionments.
