


Project Timeline



Benefits

Expanding Highway 23 from two-lanes to four-lanes will provide additional capacity, improve the movement of freight, and improve roadway safety. Expanding the highway will also provide the design consistency of a four-lane rural highway and help meet driver's expectations throughout the corridor. This corridor-wide consistency further enhances the mobility and safety benefits already provided by the expansion.

Potential Detour Routes



The construction phasing and detour routes are currently being determined and will be finalized closer to construction. Currently, a combination of County Roads 33, 32, 12, & 10 are intended to be used as potential detour routes while Highway 23 is under construction. A future Public Open House will be held to outline the construction phasing and detour routes in greater detail.
