Request for Letters of Interest for a Design Build Contract

Greetings,

The Minnesota Department of Transportation – District 3 is soliciting Letters of Interest (LOI) from companies interested in providing Design-Build services for the design and construction of Interstate 94 from Monticello to Clearwater. The proposed construction will include the reconstruction of approximately 14 miles of 194, the construction of a new general purpose lane in both directions, noise wall construction, and other associated work. The project is scheduled for a letting in April 2019. Approximate cost is \$75-85 million.

The project procurement schedule is as follows:

- Request for Letters of Interest October 10, 2018
- RFQ release Planned October 17, 2018
- Submit SOQ December 2018
- Shortlist Teams Late December 2018
- RFP Release January 9, 2018
- Request For Proposals Kick-Off and DBE Meet and Greet January 2019
- Letting Planned April 17, 2019
- Construction June 2019 through the end of the 2021 construction season

This project may utilize either a Low Bid or Best Value award structure.
