OVERVIEW

The facility comfort survey was developed to help MnDOT learn more about pedestrian comfort with a variety of roadway treatments. The survey was sent to listservs by MnDOT and MDH, publicized through Citizens League, and was also linked to via the Minnesota Pedestrian System Plan website (www.minnesotawalks.org). Nearly 800 people took the survey, with 677 people completing it in its entirety. The survey was available to anyone who wanted to take it but creating a statistically valid survey was not a part of the scope of this project. Participants who opted in to taking the survey are not necessarily a representative sample of Minnesotans.

The survey focused on two distinct roadway treatment categories: treatments for crossing a roadway, and treatments for walking along a roadway. There were ten different treatments for crossing a roadway, and seven for walking along a roadway. Each of the treatments had an accompanying image to illustrate a visual example of what each treatment looks like. The following pages provide a summary of survey respondents and aggregated responses for each question.




Figure 1: Gender of survey respondents.




Figure 2: Age breakdown of respondents.




Figure 3: Race/ethnicity of survey respondents.





Figure 4: Map displaying zip codes of survey respondents.




The following images are roadway treatments for crossing a roadway that were presented in the survey. Survey respondents were given a range of five comfort levels to choose from.




Figure 6: Comfort ratings for raised crosswalk




Figure 7: Comfort ratings for roundabout




Figure 8: Comfort ratings for median




Figure 9: Comfort ratings for flashers




Figure 10: Comfort ratings for pedestrian signal




Figure 11: Comfort ratings for bump out




Figure 12: Comfort ratings for pedestrian bridge




Figure 13: Comfort ratings for pedestrian tunnel




Figure 14: Comfort ratings for free right turn



Q12. How comfortable would you feel walking along this roadway with a sidewalk and buffer? Image 12: Sidewalk + Buffer






Figure 16: Comfort ratings for sidewalk + buffer

Image 13: Paved Shoulder







Figure 17: Comfort ratings for paved shoulder






Figure 19: Comfort ratings for shared-use path

Image 16: Bike Lane







Figure 20: Comfort ratings for bike lane




Figure 21: Comfort ratings for cycle track
