

2019 Safe Routes to School Funding Recipients

Infrastructure: Transportation Alternatives: \$2,335,000

- **City of Fosston**
To improve sidewalks and crosswalk markings along routes of access to Fosston Public Schools.
- **City of Little Falls**
To fill in sidewalk and trail gaps along 9th St. NE and 6th St. SW and to install safety improvements such as Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) at 9th St. NE, 6th St. SW, and 4th St. SW.
- **Mahnomen County**
Construction of a trail segment from TH 59 to Railway Street and sidewalk construction on Jefferson Avenue, 1st Street, and Madison Avenue.
- **City of Barnesville**
To add a trail on the east side of TH 9 to connect downtown with the commercial area at the intersection of TH 9 and TH 34.
- **City of Gaylord**
Construction of a sidewalk along Lincoln Avenue to the new elementary school and a sidewalk connecting Dakota Trail to Franklin Avenue.
- **City of Hutchinson**
Installation of a pedestrian-activated electronic crossing control system (HAWK) at the multi-use trail crossing of TH 7 and TH 22.

Infrastructure: Safe Routes to School State Funds: \$1,999,849

- **City of St. Paul***
Construction of a sidewalk connection along Idaho to connect the Community School of Excellence campus with other parts of the sidewalk grid, including construction of ADA-compliant curb ramps along existing sidewalk in the project area.
- **City of Pierz***
Construction of segment 2 of the Pierz Loop non-motorized multi-use trail.
- **City of Blue Earth***
Sidewalk construction to complete missing segments and fill gaps in the system on various roadways, ADA improvements to pedestrian ramps, railroad crossing pedestrian safety measures, additional pedestrian crossings, and trail extensions.
- **City of Parkers Prairie***
Construction of new sidewalks, ADA-compliant ramps, traffic signals, and other improvements to visibility and safety of students and other pedestrians.
- **City of Breckenridge***
Construction and improvement of sidewalks, ADA-compliant crosswalk approaches, crosswalk improvement, speed feedback signs, pedestrian beacon
- **City of Deer River***
Construction of one segment of a trail system to connect two schools, a healthcare facility, senior living facilities, fitness center, and provide access to downtown shops and businesses.

- **Cook County**
Construction of a trail connecting the school zone and sidewalk along CSAH 7 to the planned pedestrian facilities along TH 61 via a shared-use trail along the west side of CSAH 12 (Gunflint Trail).
- **City of Minneapolis**
Pedestrian improvements for this project may include signal upgrades, ADA-compliant curb ramps, bump outs, medians, signage, traffic control devices, and pavement markings at up to three high-priority intersections identified in Whittier International Elementary's Safe Routes to School Plan.
- **City of Thief River Falls**
Construct a 10' wide, 0.6 mile long multi-use trail to connect large residential neighborhoods to Franklin Middle School
- **City of Moose Lake**
Construct an off-street pedestrian corridor along TH 73 from the trail terminus at the Moose Horn River to County Road 10 roundabout and south to the school. The corridor would consist of a 10-foot-wide paved trail on the south side of TH 73 that would facilitate two-way traffic.
- **City of Hawley**
Build 12 ½ blocks of 6' wide off-road sidewalk (where none exist) including a curb bump-out at the school.
- **City of Holdingford**
Installation of sidewalk, walking path, and two school crossing warning lights. Rehabilitation of pedestrian trail from Ridge Way addition to Park Street, including a walking bridge
